To foster forward-looking thinking, the Konrad Adenauer Stiftung Morocco and the Policy Center for the New South are co-organizing a national-level policy simulation exercise. This unique event will immerse young Moroccan professionals in a dynamic foresight environment to explore potential futures for Euro-Moroccan cooperation in 2035.

Objectives

- Explore possible scenarios for Morocco–Europe relations in 2035.
- Equip participants with practical skills in strategic foresight, negotiation, and systems thinking.
- Produce actionable policy insights and joint recommendations.

Methodology: Transformative Scenario Planning (TSP) combined with policy simulation

Participants will:

Work in teams to develop 3–4 divergent scenarios for Euro-Moroccan cooperation in 2035. Engage with experts and peers in high-level simulation exercises.

Gain hands-on experience with scenario planning tools and policy design methods. Contribute to a final policy brief to be shared with decision-makers.

Receive a certificate recognizing their participation and achievements.

- Moroccan professionals, policy advisors, researchers, and civil society representatives aged 20–35.
- Strong interest in Euro-Moroccan relations, international affairs, or policy design.
- Good command of English.
